Brothers and Sisters,

So the big month for me and Sara has finally arrived, and contains a day we will remember for the rest of our lives – September 10, 2011, the day we will be married. Sara and I were very touched by the wedding shower on August 28, and the support we've had through the past year and a half at UCV for our relationship. This year we are in great need of Homework Help tutors – it is a two-hour commitment once a week (or twice a month) to spend time with a few elementary school students and help them with their homework. Often our students are children who have Spanish speaking homes that have difficulty helping their children with English-language curriculum. After working with this ministry on Wednesdays during the last school year, I can attest to how rewarding volunteering in this capacity. It doesn't require teaching or tutoring experience, just a caring concern for children. We need volunteers Monday 2:15 - 3:30 and Tuesday/Wednesday and possibly Thursday 3:15 – 4:30. Please pray on this if you have an opportunity to serve during these times.

Generally I enjoy the fall but welcome it with a sense of remorse that summer is over. As a young surfer, I loved the movie "Endless Summer" for its sense of adventure and taking a stand against the bummer of winter. However, with my marriage on the horizon, and promising things in the near future of the church, I cannot help but be exuberant about this particular fall and thankful that the season is indeed changing. From the Minister of Music

Thank you to all who provided music during the summer while our choir was taking a well-deserved break. In September, our Music Ministry programs will resume regular activities. Here are some of the musical opportunities available.

UCV Choir provides music for worship every Sunday. They rehearse weekly on **Thursday nights, 7-8:30 pm at The Community House**. We welcome all adults and youth who like to sing. No previous experience is needed. Rehearsals begin on **Thurs. Sept. 15**. If you can't commit to regular rehearsals, please consider joining us for the "cantata" which we will be presenting during worship in early December. Watch the Oct. newsletter for details about the cantata schedule, five or six rehearsals in October. and November.

Tintinnabulators is UCV's bell choir. They play UCV's beautiful English Whitechapel handbells. We're blessed with a great group of experienced ringers, but because we have five octaves, we can sure use some additional ringers to use them all! Our bell choir rehearses two or three **Sundays** a month at **11:30am** after worship and plays in worship about once a month. Especially during the holiday season, they can be found ringing in various community events as well as in church. Rehearsals begin in Oct. Talk to Lynne if you think you might be interested in ringing this year.



In past years we have had as many as three separate programs for our young children and youth. Each of these programs will be offered if there are enough interested people to make them viable. **Music Makers** is designed for our youngest children, age 3 thru 1st or 2nd grade. This group sings, plays bells and rhythm instruments and lays the foundation for further musical study. **All God's Children** (youth choir) and **Joyful Ringers** (youth handchimes/handbells) are programs for our older children and youth (grades 3-8). These programs will begin as soon as we can determine who is interested in participating and what schedule is most convenient for everyone. Please talk to Lynne if you think your child might be interested so we can make a schedule. Here at UCV we've been blessed with an abundance of talented musicians and we are grateful to all who have committed to sharing their gifts with us. Because a few of our ringers and singers have moved away this summer (and one of our ringers is benched recovering from hand surgery), we especially want to extend an invitation for new people to join us.

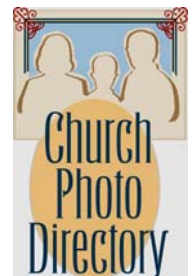
Fellowship Meals

We will explore Ecclesiastes 3:1-8 and how it speaks to each of us even though we are all in different places in

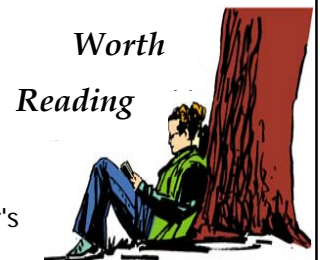

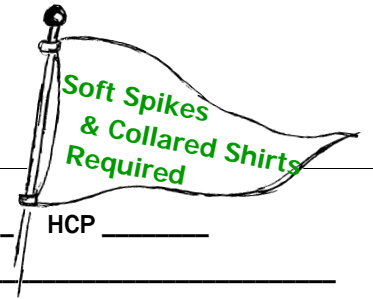
